Kez's Hideaway is a stunning purpose built family retreat, set on rural farmland close to the small township of Redesdale in Central Victoria.

This special retreat has been built in memory of Kerri Gray (who was known as Kez) in partnership with Kerri's husband and local builder, Paul Gray.

The beautiful, open-plan home features huge windows perfectly framing the views of the picturesque countryside. The spacious rooms are designed for comfort and luxury; with a parents' wing conveniently located at one end of the house, rooms for relaxation in between and a further wing featuring bedrooms and a play area for the kids or other guests.

Located 20 minutes north of Kyneton and a similar distance south-east of Heathcote offers ample opportunities for browsing antique shops and sampling local produce. A 40 minute drive will find you in the historic town of Bendigo, regional Victoria's cultural hub with access to all services you could require.

Retreat details

Location and area

Redesdale is a small town in Central Victoria, 120km (90min drive) northwest of Melbourne. The township developed from the mid-19th century to service the growing merino wool industry. It is flanked by the Coliban River to the west and the Campaspe River to the east.

Redesdale is surrounded by rolling hills and the picturesque small townships of Mia Mia, Sutton Grange, and Barfold, all of which have flourishing vineyards, and olive groves as well as traditional farming industries.

Kez's Hideaway is located on 20 acres of farmland, which has been generously donated to The OTIS Foundation by The Campbell family, third-generation local farmers. The retreat is surrounded by agricultural pastures and is opposite Mount Lofty Bushland Reserve.

The property is accessed via an unsealed road and care should be taken during wet weather.

Accommodation

Kez's Hideaway sleeps up to eight guests and is best suited for families or larger groups. It has four large bedrooms, consisting of two queen rooms and a two bedrooms with two single beds each. The retreat also includes two bathrooms and a separate disabled toilet.

Availability

Kez's Hideaway is available for four night stays from Monday to Friday or three night stays from Friday to Monday. Bookings can be made throughout the year including school holidays and public holidays (subject to availability).

Pets/smoking

Pets are not permitted and Kez's Hideaway is strictly smoke free.

Heating/Cooling

There is ducted heating and air conditioning throughout the retreat.

Key access

Kez's Hideaway requires an access code for both the electronic gates and a keybox, which holds the key to gain access to the property. Both codes will be provided to you by OTIS approximately two weeks before your stay.

What to bring

Guests are required to bring their own food and personal items. All linen including bedding and towels are provided for your use.

Other considerations:

The roads surrounding Redesdale are home to a large number of kangaroos – they can be a real hazard on the roads. Please drive carefully and slowly. Dawn and dusk are when they are most active but they can appear at any time out of nowhere and can be very unpredictable. Native animals, including snakes, can be seen close to the retreat and caution should be taken, particularly during the warmer months.

The retreat is surrounded by native trees and the house plays host to a variety of bird life and is often visited by families of kangaroos. There is also a herb and vegetable garden for guests to use, a children's playground, firepit and BBQ.
